

A Refutation of the Baseless Allegations Targeting the Somali Community in Minnesota

06 Jumada Thani 1447 H (27 November 2025) – Harakat Al-Shabaab Al Mujahideen hereby categorically rejects the baseless accusations made by the American Crusaders who have alleged that the Somali residents of Minnesota are financing the Mujahideen. Not only are these accusations inflammatory and unfounded, but they are aimed at maligning the entire Somali community in order to portray them as a threat.

Harakat Al-Shabaab Al Mujahideen notes with concern the growing wave of hostility, discrimination and hate-filled rhetoric directed at Somalis by the U.S. government, including the President Donald Trump. Such baseless claims merely seek to shift the blame onto the Somali community in the U.S. while deflecting attention away from the disastrous political failures and immense challenges facing the Trump administration.

The United States bears a dark history of involvement in Somalia, marked by the brutal killing of Somali civilians, prominent intellectuals and community leaders. Since the 1990s, U.S. forces massacred thousands of Somali civilians—women, children, elderly and respected figures within the Somali society. The most recent incident involved the killing of 12 people, among them eight children, three women and an elderly man, in the town of Jamaame, Lower Jubba region.

The outright hostility and pressure now directed at the Somalis living in the United States reflects the same pattern of hate and animosity that the Trump administration harbours towards the Muslims in general, and the Somali Muslims in particular.

While Harakat Al-Shabaab Al Mujahideen will not waver in its commitment to defend the religion, people and territorial integrity of Somalia against the disbelieving crusaders, spearheaded by the United States, it rejects any attempt to misuse its name to justify the discrimination, suffering and harassment of the Somali people, both within Somalia or abroad.

Finally, Harakat Al-Shabaab Al Mujahideen calls upon all Somalis—particularly scholars, intellectuals and community leaders—to speak out and stand firm against the blatant injustices aimed at seizing the wealth, property and rights of the Somali people.
